

APPENDIX 1

LOOKING AFTER ROADS AND PAVEMENTS

Do:

- Report any damage seen to Terry Singleton or any member of the board so repairs can be made quickly to avoid the problem increasing.
- Keep your garden in your garden; encroaching lawns and shrubs impact on the drainage of the road.
- If your property is near a road gully and you see leaves etc. give it a sweep out, it helps.

Don't

- Blow leaves into the road they end up in the road gullies and block them (all the gullies were emptied as part of the roads project)
- Allow any trades persons to use or allow materials on the roads and footpaths. If by accident this does happen you must get them to clean it immediately or if they won't you need to do it.
- Under any circumstance spill diesel oil or petrol or any other chemical products, these will have a dramatic impact on the road surface.
- Use the road gullies or allow any trades persons to use the road gullies they are for surface water only.
